

Information Sheet for Filing a Complaint about a Mandan Police Department Officer

The Mandan Police Department will decide how to investigate your complaint. The investigation may be informal, such as a discussion between you and the officer's supervisor. Or, it may be formal, which means that you, the officer and witnesses will be interviewed by Police Department investigators and a written report on the department's findings and conclusions will be prepared. You will be notified of the outcome of the investigation.

Generally, investigations and any officer discipline that may result from them are considered nonpublic, confidential records. By law, the Police Chief decides if and how an officer will be disciplined.

When you use the Police Department complaint form, it usually takes from one week to three months to receive a final response from the department.
